Litigation has begun in Australia against major sources of greenhouse gas emissions. This is expected to increase as public concern over human induced climate change grows. The recent Queensland Conservation action against Xstrata called for Queensland coal mines to be held responsible for the greenhouse gas emissions from the downstream use of their coal.

The purpose of this seminar is to inform coal industry professionals and their lawyers of the basis for climate litigation in Queensland and the legal concepts relevant to attributing liability for emissions from coal mined in Queensland. An overview of the science of climate change and the perspective of the conservation movement will also be presented.
